

The School of Chemistry Paddon-Row and Black Supplementary Postgraduate Awards

Value and Tenure

The value of these scholarships is \$5,000 tax-free per annum. The scholarships are tenable for the same period of time for which the holders are eligible for the associated Australian Postgraduate Award (APA), University Postgraduate Award (UPA), or associated Endeavour International Postgraduate Research Scholarship (EIPRS), University International Postgraduate Award (UIPA).

Outline

These scholarships have been established to encourage outstanding local as well as outstanding international students wishing to pursue a PhD in Chemistry at UNSW. The Black Scholarship will be awarded to the most outstanding applicant in Chemistry for the EIPRS/UIPA in the current round of application (Semester 1, 2008), and the Paddon-Row Scholarship to the most outstanding applicant in Chemistry for the APA/UPA in the current round of applications (Semester 1, 2008). One of each scholarship will be awarded each year, and selections will be made during the application round for commencement of study in Semester 1 of the following year.

Application and Eligibility

Students who are successful in their application for an APA/UPA or EIPRS/UIPA are automatically eligible for the Paddon-Row and Black Supplementary Scholarships respectively. Where a student is awarded the UNSW Research Excellence Award, the Chemistry supplementary scholarship will be awarded to the next most excellent candidate in Chemistry. There is no need to make a separate application for this scheme.
